

# Georgina Public Library - User Guide for OverDrive eBooks on Kobo Aura ONE

**Kobo Aura ONE eReaders allow for direct download of eBooks to the device.**

**For other Kobo versions, use the GPL User Guide for eBooks on Kobo Aura, Glo, Mini or Touch.**

*Follow the setup instructions included with your Kobo before getting started. Confirm that date, time and time zone are correct on the device.*

## Choose Georgina Public Library

1. Connect to Wi-Fi. From the Home screen of the Kobo, tap the **\*\*\*** icon in the upper-right corner.
2. Go to Settings > OverDrive. If you do not see OverDrive listed, sync your device to install the latest updates.
3. Select *Get Started* then *Create account*.
4. On the *Find a public library* screen, look for **Georgina Public Library** under Suggested Libraries or use search box to find it.
5. On the *Sign up for an OverDrive account* page, enter your email address (twice) and an 8 character password of your choice.

OverDrive will send an email to with a verification code to make sure the email address is valid. Open the message and enter the verification code when requested.

6. Select **Sign in** to add your library card to your account.
7. Tap Yes.

## Find and Download eBooks on the Kobo Aura ONE

1. Select **Browse** to start exploring Kobo's catalogue, or select Search to find a specific title.
2. Select OverDrive in the "Show" filter to limit your search results to only items in Georgina Public Library's OverDrive collection.
3. Tap an eBook cover to open its details page. If you want to borrow it, tap the **\*\*\*** More icon.
4. If a copy of the eBook is available, **Borrow with OverDrive** will be an option. Otherwise, tap on **Place a hold** with OverDrive to be added to the waiting list.
5. Select **Go to Books** to find the book you have just checked out. It will download automatically.

**Borrowed eBooks will appear in the Books section of your Kobo Aura ONE.**

## Find and Download eBooks on GPL's OverDrive website

1. Sign in at <https://odmc.overdrive.com/>.
2. Click on **Search** to search by title, author, or subject or browse using the categories listed under **Collections**. Look for the eBook indicator  **EBOOK** to make sure the format is correct.
3. When you have found a title you want, select **Borrow**. If no copies of the title are available, you may request it by selecting **Place a Hold**.
4. Enter your full 14-digit library card number and sign in. This will take you to the **Loans** section of your account.
5. Once the book is checked out on your account, the **Sync** feature on your Kobo Aura ONE will download the eBook to your device (if it has already been set up with your library card number).

**eBooks will automatically expire at the end of the lending period.**

**When a Hold becomes available, use the Sync feature on the Kobo Aura ONE to download the eBook directly to your device**
