2019 Teen Art Show Application

The Georgina Public Library is excited to announce the addition of a Teen Art Show as part of Georgina FanFest's programming for the first time ever. The artwork will be on display beginning on April 6 (Georgina FanFest) until April 28.

We are looking for art inspired by all things fandom. This means art based on or inspired by pop culture such as movies, television shows, comic books and novels, video games, music, and more. We are ONLY accepting 2D art (paintings, drawings and mixed media), not sculptures.

Requirements:

- Applicant must be in grades 7 to 12
- Art can be no larger than 20x30 inches
- Art must be ready to hang (see below)

Ready to Hang:

Ready to hang art means that if it is a painting on canvas, it has wire on the back secured with D-hooks or eye hooks approximately 1/3 of the way down the painting (see image below). If you are bringing art that is on paper (drawing, collage, painting) it must be in a frame with wire on the back to hang.

If your work is not ready to hang when you bring it to display for the show it will not be accepted.

Application:

The deadline for applications is Friday, March 15 by 5 p.m. Each applicant can submit up to 3 images for consideration by email to rcharyk@georgina.ca. Each image must be either jpeg. or pdf., and titled as such: lastname.title.imagesize(in inches). For example: **smith.hero.12x12.pdf**

Along with the image(s) of your art, please include your full name, 1-3 sentences describing each piece, your grade level, and the best phone number to contact you. This should be in the body of your email.

The Library will select artwork in its sole discretion. You will be notified by email if your art has been selected and which piece(s) to bring for the show.

Georgina FanFest Teen Art Show:

If your art has been selected you are responsible for dropping it off at the Keswick Branch (90 Wexford Drive) on Friday, April 5 between 3-6 p.m. Please note that the Library is not responsible for any damage or loss. The Library reserves the right to use images of your artwork in our marketing.

The art will be taken down on April 29 and you will be required to pick it up between Tuesday, April 30 and Friday, May 3 at 2-5 p.m. Any art not picked up by this time will become the sole property of the Library.

No artworks shall be sold through the Library or Georgina FanFest.
