Getting a Library Card

Everyone living, working, or attending school in Georgina, York Region, or Brock Township is eligible for a free library card. Bring a piece of ID with your name and current address to the library to get a library card. Children under 13 must have their card signed by a parent/guardian. If you do not meet the above requirements for a free library card, you can obtain a library card for a fee.

Renewing a Library Card

Your library card is renewed every two years. To renew your card, we will ask to see a piece of ID with your address on it.

Lost or Stolen Library Card

If your library card is lost or stolen, contact us as soon as possible. You will be responsible for materials borrowed on your card, or your child's card, until you report the card is missing.

Borrowing Periods

- 3 weeks for most items
- 7 days for DVD movies and video games
- 21 days for DVD TV Series and Binge Boxes

Renewing Library Materials

Most items can be renewed twice. Renew by phone, in-person, or online. If there is a hold on an item, the item cannot be renewed.

Fines

We are permanently fine free. What does this mean for you? No fines for overdue library materials! You will still have to pay for lost or damaged library materials. Items are considered lost if they are more than one month overdue, so remember to return or renew your materials on time.

Returning Library Materials

Library materials may be returned 24/7 through the book drop at any of our branches.
