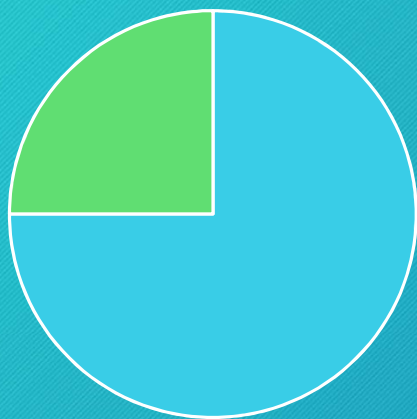

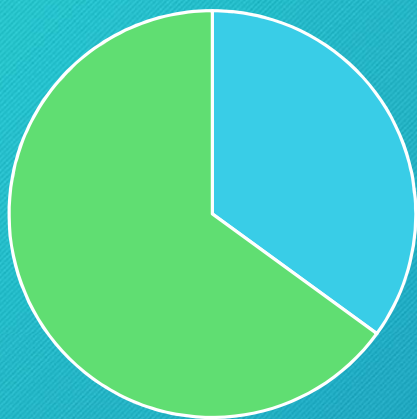
□ CYA \$3,000 □ Adult \$1,000
